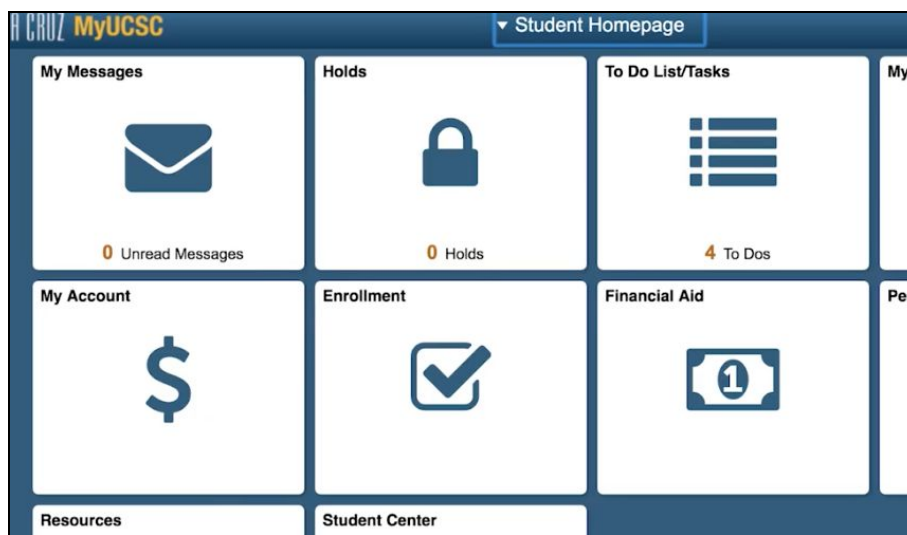


Slug Orientation How-to



Enrollment Part 1 - Search, Shopping Cart and Waitlist

Welcome to My UCSC enrollment. First you will need your CruzID and CruzID GOLD password to sign in to My UCSC. Click on the Enrollment icon on the homepage.



To search for classes, click “Class Search” in the sidebar. Your class search can be as specific or as broad as needed to find the right classes. You can specify academic terms, course subjects, class numbers, and status. Click the search button once you’ve entered any criteria. The search results displays a list of classes available based on the criteria you selected. It also shows whether or not the class is full, as indicated by a green circle if the class has spots available, or a blue square if the class has filled up.

Click on the Class Number or Class Title to view the Class Details. Be sure to review the Class Details, Description, Enrollment Requirements, and Meeting Information to make sure the class is appropriate for you. To add the course to your shopping cart, click on the “add to cart” button on the right-hand side of either the Class Search Results or the Class Detail pages.

Upon selecting the “add to cart” option, you will be prompted to include a section and indicate enrollment preferences. Under Enrollment Preferences, you may include a permission number if you have one, change
