



## Enrollment Time Conflicts

When attempting to enroll, you may encounter a red X along with an error message detailing a time conflict between specific classes. A time conflict is when two or more of your classes overlap, or are less than 15 minutes apart. This includes sections, discussions, and labs in addition to lectures.
