Admissions Records and Residency

- Request transcripts and AP/IB/other test scores to be sent to UC Santa Cruz and meet all Conditions of Admission

- Submit online Statement of Legal Residency (if requested) (Frosh deadline: May 6)



- Submit AB540 Affidavit (if applicable)
- Submit online Statement of Legal Residency (if requested) (Transfer deadline: June 6)

- July 1, Official Transcripts Deadline: All official transcripts must be postmarked or electronically submitted to UC Santa Cruz Undergraduate Admissions by 7/1
- July 15, Official Test Scores Deadline: All official test scores must be received in UC Santa Cruz Undergraduate Admissions

- Submit records/test scores not previously available



- International students to submit Secondary Graduation Certificate or equivalent as required by country

Slug Orientation and Advising

- Upload your SlugCard photo for your student ID card
- Take the Math online assessment in ALEKS if needed (frosh only)

- Complete Orientation Course Part 1
- Upload your SlugCard photo for your student ID card
- Note: Complete Parts 1 and 2 of the Orientation Course to receive your fall class enrollment appointment date; you will enroll for fall classes online

- Complete Orientation Course Part 2 by July 16
- Prepare for class enrollment—have your classes ready! (Part 2 has all the information you need to prepare to enroll in your fall quarter classes)
- You will enroll in your fall classes during your online enrollment appointment date

- Virtual Advising Days August 5-9
- Frosh students enroll for classes from August 12-16
- Transfer students enroll for classes from August 19-22
- Enrollment waitlist opens August 26
- Begin Orientation Course Part 3
- Complete Orientation Course Part 3 by August 26

- Participate in Welcome Week (details will be sent via email)
- Visit families.ucsc.edu for resources for family members and others in your support network

Financial Aid and Scholarships

- Respond to any verification requests
- Submit prior year FAFSA or Dream App if needed for Summer Edge

- Ensure To-Do items are completed (if any)
- Note: Conditional aid offers are removed by the office to prepare for official financial aid offer—you may not see information in the portal during this time

- Review and accept aid offer
- Parent loans can be requested at studentloans.gov
- Complete promissory note and entrance counseling
- Sign up for direct deposit

- Prepare and plan your budget/ payments, estimate your bill

- Apply for campus or community jobs via Handshake, the official job board of UCSC Career Success

Billing Information (Student Business Services)

- Go to *My Account* tile within your MyUCSC portal to see due dates, charges due, and to make ePayments
- First Summer Session bill posted 5/24

- Students can set up eBill/ePay, and give access to family member/parent as "other payer"
- Second Summer Session bill posted 6/21

- First Summer Session Housing due date 7/23
- Third Summer Session bill posted 7/26

- Summer tuition/fees/housing payment due in full on 8/12
- Fall charges posted to student account

- Fall charges due 09/18/2024 (check MyUCSC and your eBill if you are on a payment plan for due dates)

International Students Only (I-20/DS-2019, intending F-1/J-1 status)

- Submit I-20/DS-2019 request and other supporting documents
- Register for International Student Orientation
- Review and respond to emails sent from International Student Services and Programs (ISSP). Always include your full name and Student ID

- Book visa interview appointment after you receive your I-20/DS-2019
- Pay SEVIS fee (I-901 fee) at least 5 business days prior to interview
- Secure student visa. Do not book your ticket to arrive sooner than 30 days prior to the I-20/Ds-2019 start date, as that is the earliest you can enter the U.S.

- If you have not already done so, book your visa interview appointment, pay SEVIS fee, secure student visa and prepare for travel. Do not book your ticket to arrive sooner than 30 days prior to I-20/Ds-2019 start date, as that is the earliest you can enter the U.S.

- Attend International Student Orientation
- Submit Secondary Graduation Certificate immediately upon arriving on campus to Undergraduate Admissions

Health and Immunization Records

- Complete the Immunization and TB Screening Requirements prior to arriving on campus to avoid registration holds. Instructions on how to upload your records can be found on the Student Health Requirements section of the Health Center website at healthcenter.ucsc.edu



Health Insurance

- Review waiver dates and the UC SHIP (UC Student Health Insurance Plan) coverage dates and rates for Summer Edge and Fall Students on the Billing and Insurance webpage at healthcenter.ucsc.edu

- SUMMER EDGE STUDENTS:** If you want UC SHIP, you don't need to do anything further. You'll be automatically enrolled and billed for your quarterly premium. If you want to use a different insurance plan and WAIVE out of the UC Student Health Insurance Plan, you must complete an online insurance waiver by 7/1/24 and SUBMIT proof of your other qualifying insurance. Housing

- Mid-May: New frosh apply for university housing at studenthousing.ucsc.edu. Application instructions are sent to UCSC email addresses for students who indicate a preference for university housing during the admissions acceptance process. Students who indicate a preference for finding their own off-campus housing are sent information about the resources available through the UCSC Community Rentals Office (communityrentals.ucsc.edu).

- Mid-June: New transfers and new visiting students apply for university housing at studenthousing.ucsc.edu. Application instructions are sent to UCSC email addresses for students who indicated a preference for university housing during the admissions acceptance process. Students who indicate a preference for finding their own off-campus housing are sent information about the resources available through the UCSC Community Rentals Office (communityrentals.ucsc.edu).

- July 23, 2024: Summer Session 1, 8-week, and 10-week housing fees are due. Visit the MyUCSC Portal (my.ucsc.edu) to view a billing statement and submit payment.



- August 12, 2024: Summer Session 2 and Summer Edge housing fees are due. Visit the MyUCSC Portal (my.ucsc.edu) to view a billing statement and submit payment.



- September 18, 2024: Academic year housing fees are due. Visit the MyUCSC Portal (my.ucsc.edu) to view a billing statement and submit payment.
- September 19-22, 2024 (approximately): Fall Move-in. Visit housing.ucsc.edu/move-in.
